Guidelines for Paper Proposals

Language

Paper proposals for any session must be submitted in English or French.

Paper Title

- The title cannot exceed 25 words
- Do not write your title in quotation marks
- Do not use ALL CAPS and Capitalize titles in English as per the example below:

- Politics in a World of Inequality*
- Politics in a world of inequality*
- POLITICS IN A WORLD OF INEQUALITY*
- "Politics in a World of Inequality"*

Paper Abstract

- The following points should be covered in your Abstract:
 1. the research question your paper investigates
 2. a very brief description of the methodological approach
- The Abstract must not exceed 350 words.
- Do not include references, bibliographical notes, or your contact information in the abstract text.
- Review your use of language.
